

What to Bring List

Items we recommend the Camp Coordinator bring:

Item	Notes
Tea Towels	** Mandatory. As per health department requirements 3 x per day
Sharp knives	We have a wide range of knives however our knives are not always the sharpest, so we recommend you bring your own knives for preparing food with if you prefer
Rice Cookers	If you are preparing food for large groups, you may want to bring an additional rice cooker. Camp Seed has 1 Rice Cooker however additional might be required for your group
Slow Cookers	If you are preparing food for large groups, you may want to bring an additional Slow Cooker. Camp Seed has 2 Slow Cookers however additional might be required for your group
Table Cloths & Napkins	For fancy display of your food please feel free to bring your own to assist with your food presentations
Toilet Paper	A supply of toilet paper is provided for 48 guests for approx. 2-3 days. For longer stays were recommend you provide additional rolls as required.
First Aid Kit	It is recommended that you appoint a First Aid Coordinator and they supply 1 fully equipped First Aid Kit
General Kitchen Cleaning items	The basics are provided however if you are staying for an extended period it is possible you will run out. You can either bring extra items to ensure you are covered or can purchase items from St Arnaud which is the nearest town with a supermarket
Table Tennis	We supply table tennis bats and a few balls. These often go missing or get broken, please feel free to bring extras should you think you will need them
Camp Chairs (outdoors)	Some seating outdoors is provided however you may want to sit around the camp fire in a comfy chair therefore we recommend you asking your guests to bring a camp chair is they wish

Items we recommend Overnight Visitors bring:

Item	Quantity	Notes
Linen	1 x Pillow Case 2 x Sheets	Mandatory for health regulations
Bedding	1 x Doona or Sleeping Bag 1 x Pillow	Each bed has a pillow and a blanket supplied however visitors may prefer to use their own bedding
Towels	1 x Bath Towel 1 x Face Washer 1 x Beach Towel	Mandatory for health regulations Beach towel is useful if visiting the Reservoir or using the local council run swimming pools. Please note; the St Arnaud Swimming Pool has free entry in Summer
Toiletries	As required	
Refillable Water Bottles	As required	
Sunscreen	As required	
Insect Repellent	As Required

Marshmallows	TBC	To roast over the camp fire
Camp Chairs	As required	It's nice to sit around the camp fire at night in a comfy chair. We have wooden logs surrounding the camp fire, but you might want to bring a comfy one
